### 2020 C.A.S.P.E.R. Youth Basketball Program

This year due to COVID-19, each team will need to follow the guidelines provided by the State and our local Health Department. Below is the list of guidelines each player and team will need to follow.

#### **Youth Basketball Season**

- This proposal meets the current state guidelines for groups of no more than 50. For youth basketball, this is adjusted to provide space for 20 players with 2 officials and 1 scorekeeper per court.
- 2 spectators per player will be allowed in gym during games.
- Teams will need to leave the gym immediately after the game is over.
- Teams must maintain social distancing when entering and leaving the facility.
- No congregating outside the gym lobby after the game is completed.
- Each team will be required to hand sanitize before each game, hand sanitizer will be provided for your protection.
- Per the NCSD and Health Department policies, face coverings are required for all recreation staff, spectators, coaches.
- After each game, the gym supervisor will sanitize each basketball before the next game starts.
- We recommend that players do not share equipment or personal items with teammates.
- Team meetings must honor the social distancing requirements.

Please understand that the City of Casper Parks and Recreation Department & Natrona County School District are following the requirements from the State and our Local Health Department. If these requirements change in the coming weeks or months, we will implement a new/modified plan for this tournament. We appreciate your understanding and support during this time.
