2020 Adult Softball Tournament

Team Managers,

This year due to COVID-19 each team will need to follow the guidelines provided by the State and our local Health Department. Below is the list of guidelines each player and team will need to follow as of August 1, 2020.

Adult Softball Tournament

- This proposal meets the current state guidelines for groups of no more than 250.
- Participants and spectators, that are not from the same household, must maintain their social distance of 6 ft. Team meetings at home plate must also honor the social distancing requirements.
- Three (3) people per team will be allowed in the dugout at one time. They must maintain their social distance while in the dugout (one (1) score keeper plus the next two (2) batters in order)
- Each team will be required to social distance outside of the dugout along the fence line on each field during practices and games. Players will be asked to position themselves and place their equipment along the fence at a distance of 6 feet apart.
- Teams will have to leave the field immediately after the game is over. The incoming teams may enter the fields once the previous teams have completely left.
- Hand sanitizer will be provided in each dugout for your protection.
- Face coverings are required for all staff and recommended for players.
- After each game, the umpires or field supervisors should sanitize the softballs before the next game starts.
- There will be no shaking of hands after the contest is completed.
- We recommend that players do not share equipment or personal items with team mates.
- The Crossroads Complex bathrooms will remain closed.

Please understand that the City of Casper Parks and Recreation Department is following the requirements from the State and our Local Health Department. If these requirements change in the coming weeks or months, we will implement a new/modified plan for this tournament. We appreciate your understanding and support during this time.
