2021 Girls' JO Fast Pitch and Coach Pitch Softball

Coaches and parents,

This year due to COVID-19 each player/team will need to follow the guidelines provided by the State and our local Health Department. Below is the list of guidelines each player/team will need to follow:

- Three (3) people per team will be allowed in the dugout at any time. They must maintain their social distance while in the dugout (one (1) score keeper plus the next two (2) batters in order)
- Each team will be required to social distance outside of the dugout along the fence line on each field during practices and games. Players will be asked to position themselves and place their equipment along the fence at a distance of 6 feet apart.
- Teams will have to leave the field immediately after the game is over. The incoming teams may enter the field once the previous teams have completely vacated.
- We recommend that participants and spectators do not congregate outside the field or in the parking lot before or after games or practices.
- Hand sanitizer will be provided for your protection.
- Face coverings are required for staff and recommended for players.
- There will be no shaking of hands after the contest is completed.
- We recommend that players do not share equipment or personal items with team mates.
- Team meetings must honor the social distancing requirements.
- Each player is recommended to have their own helmet and glove.

We understand there are many new requirements for this season. Please understand that the City of Casper Parks and Recreation Department is following the State and Local Health Department requirements. If the requirements change, we will implement a new/modified plan for our program. We appreciate your understanding and support.
